

Multi Pre-Loader (20) Action 1.0.2

This action will let you pre-load up to 20 images to your visitors browser - much more convenient than using a single action for each pre-load. This is ideal for image menus, slide shows, and any other similar application. If you need to pre-load more than 20 images, you can just add another copy of the action to your page for the remaining images - up to as many as you need.

Here's how to install the action:

Decompress the ZIP or SIT file (use Stuffit Expander on Mac) and put it into a new folder named "MindPalette" (if you don't already have a MindPalette folder in your GoLive actions). Put the MindPalette folder into your GoLive actions folder, which you can find here on your computer:

(Main GoLive Folder) / Modules / JScripts / Actions

Here's how to use the action in your page:

Display the head section of your document by clicking the arrow by the page icon at the top left corner of your Golive document window.

Next, drag in a "head action" object from the "smart" tab of the objects palette (GL 5 and 6). Select the new head action and set it to "OnLoad" and link to any images that you would like to have the browser pre-load into cache.

Some people like to pre-load their images "on parse" instead of "on load", but I generally like to use "on load" so the rest of the page can be displayed before the images start pre-loading. It's purely a matter of preference.
